Grading system	Practical Observation: Assessments are carried out when the tutor observes the learner carrying out the practical work to the tutor's satisfaction. Tutor must be convinced that the learner can perform the tasks assigned to them without help and within the time frame specified. Written assignments and / or portfolios Each unit of learning is composed of a number of learning outcomes which are judged by means of written assignments or portfolios. These can include tables, charts and reports that are the result of the students referenced research. Differently able students Those students that are confirmed by the relevant authority - may be allowed to produce evidence of their knowledge and an understanding of the subjects by alternative means.
